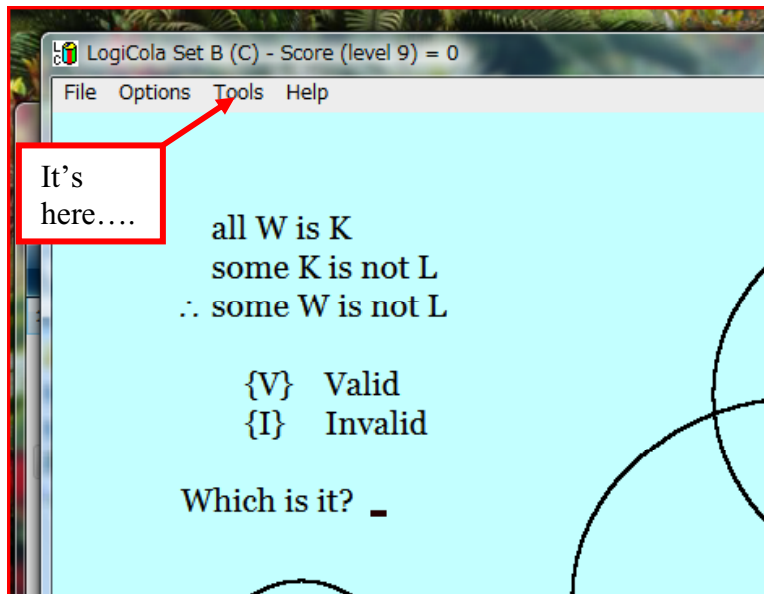


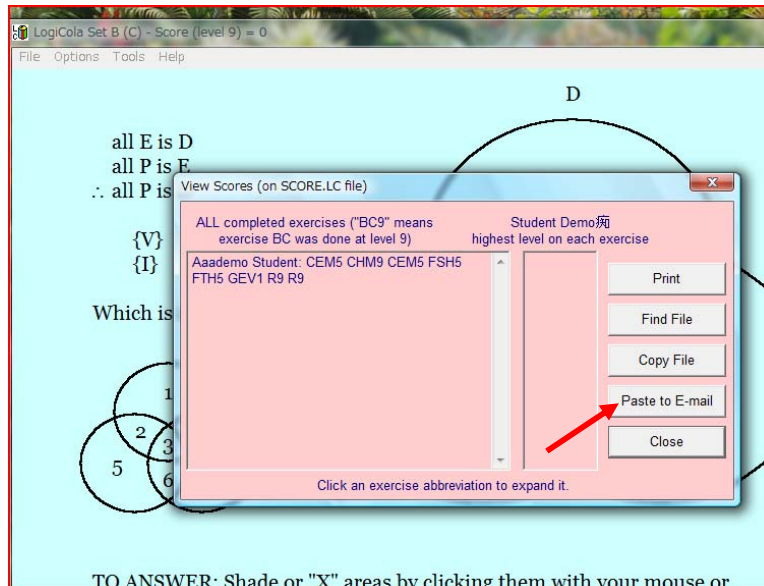
Submitting LogiCola Homework Exercises as WebCT Assignments

First, you'll need both LogiCola and WebCT open at the same time. Open both now, if you need to.

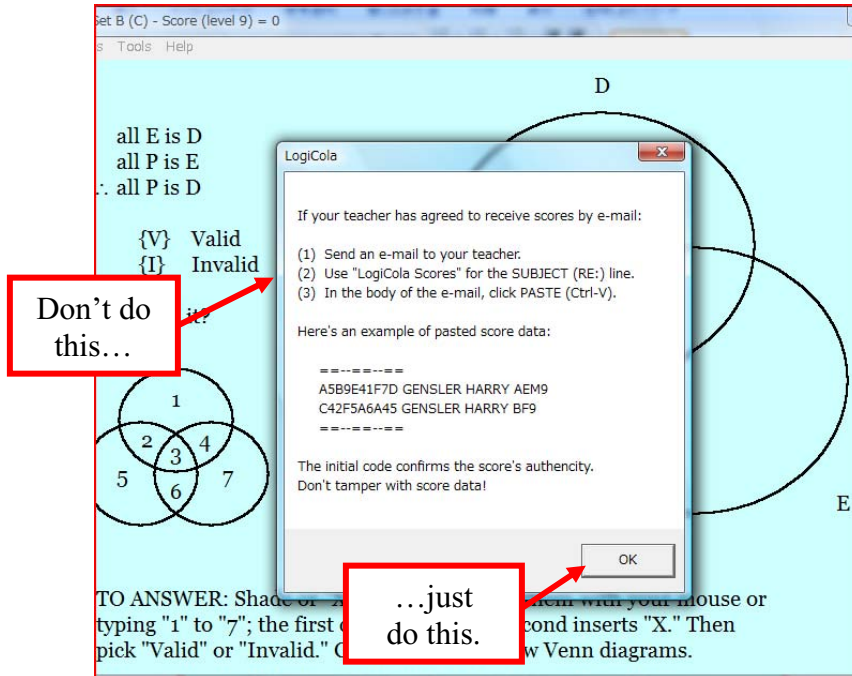
Next, Go to the Tools Menu of LogiCola, and select "view or e-mail scores...". (Sorry, but I couldn't get the menu to stay pulled down for the screen shot.)



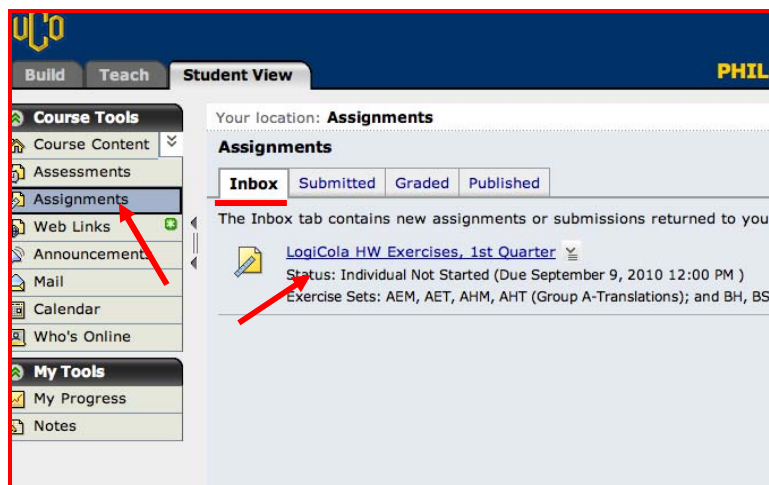
A window like below will pop up. Click "Paste to E-mail".



Another window (below) will pop up. DO NOT START AN EMAIL, as it tells you to do, but DO go ahead and click “OK”.



Next, go to the Course Tools > Assignments > Inbox area of WebCT, and click on the assignment you plan to submit.



On the individual assignment page which opens, find the Submission window and click in it. DO NOT use any of the html or attachment tools.

Now press Ctrl-V, or use your computer's main menu "paste" command. Some encoded-looking text like below will appear in the submission box.


