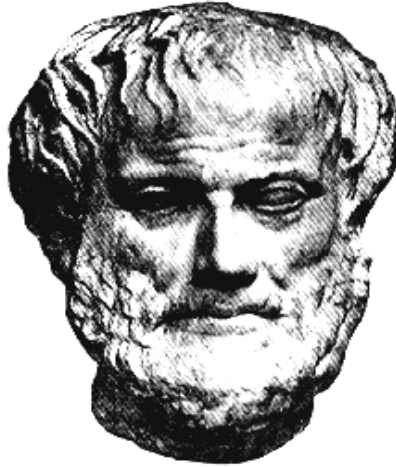


Philosophy = reasoning about
